- Principal Report - Dr. McCoy

PSAT occurred face-to-face (250-300 students). SAT for juniors on March 3rd. Dr. McCoy talked about the success of college fairs, CTE events that have worked well. He discussed some opportunities for continued online opportunities such as PTO (engagement is higher). Winter sports have started. Board approved payment for the Peterson Events Center. There will be social distancing there. There will likely be limited seating available. AP Exams will be likely in person and online. Some are not offered online. Payment is still being working out-there will be an online payment but they are trying to figure out a payment for those that cannot pay online. Languages will not be offered online (face-to-face). The first window for testing is early May. Still thinking Keystones could happen, which would be mid-May. Scholarship Night is typically targeted at Junior and Seniors but they are open to all. Dr. McCoy mentioned it is ideal for juniors but that anyone can and should come. The projected date for graduation is June 12/13. Likely the 13th in the evening. Question about the end-of-year events such as prom. All events need to be approved. If parents have ideas, how could they communicate them to the school or the district more broadly-- Dr. McCoy or Ms. Davies are good people to email. Dr. McCoy reiterated that there are no current plans because everything has to be approved. Dr. McCoy explained the WIN Wednesdays-- regardless of the programming, there would have always been half days. So the students would have had 16 min class periods and so this is a way to capitalize on this and provide an intervention time for the students who really need it.
